


Thank you for purchasing **Soundsation Cream 30R** Guitar Amplifier.

To get the best performance from your new amplifier, please read this instruction manual carefully.



**1. INPUT** Plug your guitar here

**2. VOLUME** Use this control to adjust the output level of clean

3. PUSH/PUSH SWITCH Selects Clean/Drive channel

4. GAIN Adjusts the level of the Drive channel in conjunction with the Volume control5. VOLUME Adjusts the level of the Drive channel in conjunction with the Gain control

6. BASS Controls the low frequencies range
7. MIDDLE Controls the middle frequencies range
8. TREBLE Controls the high frequencies range
9. REVERB Adjusts the reverb level for both channels

**10. AUX IN** Auxiliary input 3.5" jack (not affected by amp settings)

**11. FOOTSWITCH** By connecting this jack it is possible to remotely switch reverb ON/OFF

**12. HEADPHONES** Headphones stereo output jack. This jack can also be used as an unbalance

line output

13. POWER SWITCH Turns the unit ON and OFF14. FUSE See rear panel for correct value

**15. AC INPUT**Connect the power cord in accordance with the voltage

## **IMPORTANT**

To avoid risk of electrical shock do not expose to water or damp.

Always connect your instrument cable to your guitar before connecting to your amplifier. Connecting to your amplifier first may cause damage to the speaker.

Do not leave your guitar unattended with the volume turned up.

Neon or fluorescent lighting near the amplifier may cause slight hum or noise. This can frequently be eliminated by changing the position of your instrument or the amplifier and using cables with good shielding.

To avoid injuring your ears or damaging your headphones, reduce amplifier volume before plugging in your headphones.

Plugging in headphones will turn off your amplifier speaker.

Always unplug amp from mains before replacing the fuse.

## **WARRANTY AND SERVICE**

All SOUNDSATION products feature a limited two-year warranty. This two-year warranty is specific to the date of purchase as shown on your purchase receipt.

The following cases/components are not covered from the above warranty:

- Any accessories supplied with the product
- Improper use
- Fault due to wear and tear
- Any modification of the product effected by the user or a third party

SOUNDSATION shall satisfy the warranty obligations by remedying any material or manufacturing faults free of charge at SOUNDSATION's discretion either by repair or by exchanging individual parts or the entire appliance. Any defective parts removed from a product during the course of a warranty claim shall become the property of SOUNDSATION.

While under warranty period, defective products may be returned to your local SOUNDSATION dealer together with original proof of purchase. To avoid any damages in transit, please use the original packaging if available. Alternatively you can send the product to SOUNDSATION SERVICE CENTER – Via Enzo Ferrari, 10 – 62017 Porto Recanati - Italy . In order to send a product to service center you need an RMA number. Shipping charges have to be covered by the owner of the product.
